- ☐ Map showing the region where this group lived
- ☐ Picture of the environment
- ☐ Caption sentence describing the environment
- ☐ **Section labeled: Food**
- ☐ Picture of the foods this group ate
- ☐ Caption sentence listing the foods this group ate
- ☐ Picture showing how this group got food
- ☐ Caption sentence explaining how this group got food
- ☐ **Section labeled: Homes**
- ☐ Picture of the group's homes
- ☐ Label telling what this type of home is called
- ☐ Caption sentence describing what this home is made of
- ☐ **Section labeled: Government**
- ☐ Picture showing leaders
- ☐ Caption sentence explaining how this group was organized and who its leaders were
- ☐ **Section labeled: Religion**
- ☐ Picture showing something about this group's religion
- ☐ Caption sentence explaining what this group believed to be holy
- ☐ Caption sentence explaining how this group honored or celebrated what they believed to be holy
