
Perspective Notes



Third Person point-of-view:

- Tell what the character did and said from an outside viewer's perspective.
- Use the main character's name.
- Key words: he, she, it, his, her, hers, they, them, theirs
- Example: The exhausted man on the island finally saw a boat coming to save him!

First Person point-of-view:

- Write as if **you** are the **character** telling the story.
- Tell what the **character** thought and **felt** when events happened, from a **personal** perspective.
- Key words: I, me, my, mine, we, us, our, ours
- Example: I jumped for joy when I saw a boat on the horizon!

Second Person point-of-view:

- Write as if the **character** is telling the story directly to the **reader**.
- The **reader/audience** becomes a **character** (you), to whom the story is addressed.
- Key words: **you**, your, yours
- Example: You saved my life when you rowed into sight!
