

# Exodus Final Study Guide



## What to expect:

Your final over the Book of Exodus will include information from Chapters 1-33. It will mostly expect you to recognize the important people, places, and events from the Book of Exodus. The test will give you a description, and ask you to provide the name or term. There will NOT be a word bank.

You will be allowed to use your Bible to help you, but you will NOT get extra time beyond class, so you must prepare in advance... There will not be enough time to “look for” every answer in your Bible.

## How can you prepare?

- Read through your spiral’s notes. Jot down what you notice in each of these categories:
  - Pay special attention to names of people that are repeated, or who do something really important.
  - Pay attention to places where important things happen, and know the places’ names.
  - Pay attention to significant events, especially ones that are so important that they have a special name!

- Read the overview of Exodus, called “In Depth” on the page before Exodus chapter 1. Jot down terms, major people, places, and events here:
- Read the section headings in Exodus 1-17, Exodus 19-20, and Exodus 32-33. Think to yourself what you remember about each topic. Only take time to read the details in that section if you have no idea what it was about.
- Jot down answers to these questions:
  - What did God say to Moses from the burning bush?
  - What was the main message Moses had for Pharaoh?
  - What did the Israelites do right after the Egyptians were drowned? \_\_\_\_\_ What character is mentioned by name related to this activity?
- Read the “Did You Know?” article about the Ark of the Covenant at the start of Exodus 37.
