

## Genesis 12 Reflection

- \* Read Genesis 12:10-20 and write a half-page (or more) reflection from the perspective that your teacher assigns to you. Write as if you are the character from the Bible. (You **may not** use the words *happy, sad, mad, bad, good* to describe their feelings. Instead, use specific vocabulary to express their emotions!)
- \* Circle your assigned role:
  - \* *Sarai's journal entry prompt:* What does Sarai experience in Egypt? How does she feel about Abram?
  - \* *God's journal entry prompt:* How does God feel about Sarai, Abram, and Pharaoh throughout this story? (Be specific about who, when, and why God feels that way for each part of your answer!)
  - \* *Abram's apology letter:* What might Abram say to Sarai to help her heal from her ordeal in Pharaoh's house?

### Applying Genesis 12:10-20 to your own life:

Write about a time in your own life that in some way resembled any part of this Genesis story. Describe what happened in your life, and explain how it connects to the story.

Then, write a 3 to 5 sentence prayer for God's healing from that situation.

(Your total entry should be at least 3/4 of a page in length.)
