

Rock Cycle Poster

Goal: Create a poster to describe one of the three types of rock in detail.

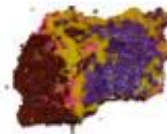
Required Elements:

- Title telling name of your type of rock: _____
- names of the poster authors below the title (smaller)
- definition of your type of rock
- diagram of the complete rock cycle, with your rock type made to stand out visually from the rest. (include images of the 3 types of rock, not just their names)
- at least 3 details about your rock type (these could include how it forms, where it forms, special vocabulary related to your type of rock, or other details you find)
- 3 or more examples of rocks that are in your rock type's category (use the booklet from your notes). Each of the 3 examples should include:
 - name of example rock
 - hand-drawn, colored picture of example rock
 - detailed description of example rock

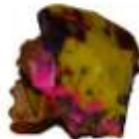
General Expectations:

- poster is neat and well-organized (includes labels, captions, etc. and similar information is grouped together)
- all conventions are correct (spelling, capitalization, punctuation, grammar)
- pictures are neatly drawn and fully colored
- all words are legible and easy to read from a distance of 5 feet away
- all group members contributed equally to making the poster
- all group members worked together cooperatively
- all group members agreed on the content of the poster before it was written/drawn/attached
